Each New Day**

The Most Holy Trinity is Who we celebrate in this Most Holy Solemnity this Sunday: God the Father, Jesus the Son, and the Holy Spirit. We celebrate that the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit have been revealed in the human history of creation, salvation, and of sanctification (to be made holy).

In the Book of Genesis, we read about the creation story of our universe, world, all living things, and man and woman, who were especially made in God's Image and Likeness. We also read in Genesis about the fall of Adam and Eve, and God as a loving Father, Who made a covenant through Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, and Moses and the prophets, in order to bring man and woman back into a right relationship.

We then read in the New Testament of the Bible that in the fullness of time, God sent His Son Jesus to teach us about God's Kingdom and through His Death on the Cross and His Resurrection, we now have free access to salvation and everlasting life. Also, by receiving the Holy Spirit through the Sacraments of the Church, we can live a holy life that will prepare us for life in Heaven after our life here on Earth. Making the Sign of the Cross = The Holy Trinity

Making the Sign of the Cross, with our right hand, from our forehead, to our stomach, to our left shoulder, and then to our right shoulder, is one of the first prayers we are taught. We do this as we begin our prayer, whether we are alone praying, or with other people, such as praying before dinner with our family.

The words we use in making the Sign of the Cross as we begin are; In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, Amen! In beginning and ending prayer this way, we are addressing our prayer to God, Who is Father, Jesus, Who is Son, and Holy Spirit. We are, therefore, praying to The Holy Trinity; Three Persons in One God. It is important to understand this because each of us has a relationship with God the Father, Jesus the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

The times we are to bless ourselves are: When we enter the Church, you bless yourself with Holy Water, before you enter the pew, you genuflect and bless yourself, when the priest says, "In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit" at the beginning of Mass, and at the end of Mass during the final blessing, we bless ourselves.

Every time we bless ourselves, we are doing it in the Name of and in Honor of The Holy Trinity; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Amen!

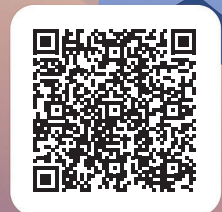
