A Family Perspective

Today's Gospel is clear. Commitment to another involves sacrifice. Before we accept commitments such as marriage and parenting, we must plan carefully, like the king in today's Gospel. These are serious commitments that demand complete self-giving and are not for the faint-hearted or selfish.

Parenting Pointer #1111

If your kids are of school age, September can be a hectic time. Some children are naturally organized. Others need the help of a daily/weekly calendar, a check list, a bedtime review, etc. Ask your child what might help them, even if it is *you* getting out of the way.

FULLY-COMMITTED

Those of you who have served or are currently serving in the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, Coast Guard, or Merchant Marines know first-hand how important and necessary it is to go through weeks of basic training. You have to know how to handle yourself in dangerous situations and know the proper use of weapons during tactical training. You have to learn about your branch of the military that you chose. Even before applying for and entering military service, you were first drawn to this way of life by the example of someone who was serving our country. Because of your love for your country, you answered the call to be fully committed in defending our freedoms and rights. Just as there is a cost of months of training and being separated from family and homeland for a while of a person who serves in a branch of the military, so too, in our Gospel Reading this weekend, Jesus describes the cost of discipleship for those who choose to follow Him.

Jesus describes three necessary ways of training in order to live and to develop our discipleship. He says, "If anyone comes to Me without hating his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, even his own life, he cannot be my disciple." (Lk 14: 26) *Wait a minute!* We are to love our parents. That is the 4th Commandment. We are also to love family, aren't we? YES, OF COURSE! Jesus uses these extreme words to get our attention and to cause us to prefer Him first and foremost in our lives, above any other relationship we have in life.

Jesus also says, "Whoever does not carry his own cross and come after Me cannot be My Disciple." (Lk 14: 27) Actually, our crosses are the joy of our vocations we choose in life and the daily duties and responsibilities that are before us. We all know that many people carry heavy crosses and they need our help and our prayers.

Finally, Jesus says, "Any one of you who does not renounce all his possessions cannot be My Disciple." (Lk 14: 33) In other words, put all that you have and own in the Hands of God and never allow it to control your life." Strive to live with less things.

My brothers and sisters, do not be overwhelmed by these directives that Jesus is giving us on discipleship. Just strive to follow Jesus by loving God, your neighbor, and yourself, in this order, everyday. Be a fully committed disciple--one day at a time; one step at a time.
