Receiving Forgiveness then Forgiving Others

One of Jesus' Famous Stories about forgiveness is read at Mass this weekend about the Prodigal Son. It is a story of a selfish young man, whose life was very misdirected by the love of money and pleasure. After his so-called friends abandoned him, and he suffered hunger and want for a period of time, he came to his senses and returned to his father's house. He returned a changed person. Fortunately for him, he had a loving, forgiving father, who accepted him unconditionally. The father loved him so much that he gave his son the symbols of being restored back to a family and right relationship. These <u>ancient Jewish symbols</u> were the *robe, ring,* and *sandals,* and then a *feast*.

We can see clearly how the relationship of the father and younger son unfolded. But there was an older son who was very jealous of the younger son. This son was always with the father, and obeyed all of the father's commands. The older son scolded his father for being so forgiving and generous to his wayward son and would not go into the banquet. After the father pleaded with the older son to come and celebrate, it is very possible that the older son may have joined them at the banquet. Jesus leaves the conclusion open-ended. We would want to believe that the older son changed his heart right then, forgave his younger brother, and then went to the celebration.

My friends, a good question for each of us may be "When in our lives are we like the older son?" ...pointing out sins in other people's lives, hypocritical to those around us, or thinking we are a much more faithful Catholic and better person compared to others who are far away from their Catholic faith?

If we are like the unforgiving older son, then we need to know that our Heavenly Father comes to us and pleads with us to be forgiving and merciful, as He is forgiving and merciful. The first step towards this attitude is to pray for the grace to be willing to be forgiving toward others.

Finally, when we are like the younger son, in need of reconciliation with God our Heavenly Father, go to the Sacrament of Confession and receive the joy and peace this Sacrament gives and then be willing to forgive others.
