ADVENT Prepare, Do It, and Be It

We do a lot of things to prepare for the winter months. There is the final mowing of the grass, cleaning out the gutters, hanging up all of the garden tools that are used for trimming, and sharpening the blades to ready them for the next summer. We store away lawn furniture, bicycles, motorcycles, and even certain cars for the next several months. In addition, we also get out our winter clothing of warm jackets, sweaters, hats, and gloves. We are now ready for cold temperatures. We also prepare our homes with decorations and make a grocery list to prepare for people, friends, and relatives who are coming for dinner and those who will stay for a couple days.

This Holy Season of Advent is a time to prepare. Just as we naturally respond to all of the necessary preparations for winter months and as we prepare to celebrate Christmas with significant people in our lives, what are you doing in order to prepare for Christ's Coming into your heart and lives during this Holy Season?

Jesus says in the Gospel Reading "...you also must be prepared for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come." (Mt 24: 44) Ways that we can prepare for Jesus' Coming into our lives are the following:

- Offer your prayers each day and when you are done, sit quietly and just BE in the Lord's Presence. Wait silently for about 5 minutes or more, then conclude by making the Sign of the Cross slowly.
- Have a special intention that you want to pray for during this Advent Season, including at least one other person and praying for their intention.

My brothers and sisters, I believe that many of us have special practices that we do during this Holy Season. Let Advent be a more fulfilling experience of preparing for Christ's Coming by doing kind acts for others and simply by being in God's Presence.

Tradition says the prayer should be recited 15 times each day. It is intended to help the faithful prepare spiritually for Christmas, reflecting on the anticipation of Christ's birth.
