The Lord is Kind and Merciful... So, Do to Others... (Sharing Our Faith)

First Reading:

(1 Samuel 26: 2,7-9, 12-13, 22-23)

In this First Reading, King Saul is on the search for David, in order to kill him because he was jealous of David. David's attendant, Abishai, was ready to take the king's sword and kill him. David refused and said, "do not harm him, for who can lay hands on the Lord's Anointed and remain unpunished." (1 Samuel 26: 9) In sparing Saul's life from Abishai, David was being kind and merciful.

Psalm Response:

(Psalm 103)

Reflect on the following verse of this Psalm and answer the two questions.

"He pardons all your iniquities, heals all your ills. He redeems your life from destruction, crowns you with kindness and compassion." (Psalm 103: 3-4)

--From what iniquities or ills has God healed you from? --Where in your life have you experienced our Lord's Kindness and Compassion?

Second Reading:

(1 Corinthians 15: 45-49)

Do we think that our Lord Jesus Christ wants us to image Him to the whole world each day? Yes. One effective way we can do this is by striving to be loving and forgiving to others. Even if we might not feel like doing this, pray for the grace to be at peace in your own thoughts about someone who has hurt you. In time, if you are consistent with this prayer for peace, the Lord will help you go to the next level of forgiveness and mercy toward that person.

Gospel:

There is a lot that Jesus is saying in this **Sermon** on the Plain according to Saint Luke. It can all be summed up to be--kind and merciful. Some of Jesus's list of being kind and merciful are the following:

"do to others as you would have them do to you"

(Luke 6: 31)

"love your enemies, do good to those who hate you" (Luke 6: 35)

(Luke 6: 30)

"give to everyone who asks of you"

"stop judging and you will not be judged" (Luke 6: 37)

My brothers and sisters, we might not always feel like we can live these Scripture Passages or want to take a risk in being kind and merciful to people who treat us badly and unfairly. I believe the answer is to pray for those who are not kind and merciful to you and work at trying to see the good that is within them. You may never become their friend but never stop praying for them and believe for them that the good in them will God Bless, Father Mark be their salvation.

SILENCE

Many times throughout the day, our lives are full of good activity such as work, talking, listening, watching, walking, and thinking. Silence is something that may happen when we are driving and especially when we are sleeping; but silence is so important for our spiritual life.

Quieting our hearts down in the morning and in the evening before we offer our prayers to God, helps us to pray and to listen to God speaking to us in our hearts. A Psalm in the Old Testament that for many centuries has given the people of Israel and us Christians, up to our time today, a lot of peace is Psalm 46 Verses 11 and 12, which reads as follows: "Be still and confess that I am God! I am exalted among the nations, exalted on the earth. The Lord of Host is with us, our stronghold is the God of Jacob."

This Psalm encourages us to be still and quiet in order for us to feel and know God's Presence and God's Peace within us. The last verse of this Psalm then gives us the calm assurance that the Lord is with us when we are being still and offering our prayers. Being silent is a tremendous help for us as we reflect on this Psalm. Our God can speak to each of us in the most effective ways when we are silent and still in His Presence. Amen.
