

#### THESE ANGELS PROTECT US

#### Angels are popular today. Here are three...

On September 29th, we celebrate the Feast of the Archangels Michael, Raphael, and Gabriel. **The Archangel Michael** is the one who with his angels in heaven battled against the dragon and its angels who symbolize evil. As the <u>Book of Revelations</u> says, "...the dragon and his angels fought back, but they did not prevail and there was no longer a place for them in heaven.: (Rev 12: 8)

There is a special prayer to **Saint Michael the Archangel** that starts out "...Saint Michael the Archangel, defend us from battle..." (**listed below**)

**The Archangel Raphael** is read about in the Book of Tobit. Raphael appears to Tobiah, Tobit's son, and leads him to marry Sarah and to bring healing to Tobit's blindness.

The name **GABRIEL** means "man of God." He was the angel who appeared to Zechariah to announce the birth of St. John the Baptizer (Luke 1: 11). Finally, he announced to Mary that she would bear a Son Who would be conceived by the Holy Spirit, Son of the Most High, and the Savior of the world. (Luke 1: 26). (Lives of the Saints, page 405)

BULLETIN INFORMATION Groups or individuals wishing to have information published in the bulletin are asked to submit the information in writing, by email or by phone by Monday at 10:00 a.m.

**Baptism** – A baptism preparation session is required of all parents wishing to have their child(ren) baptized. Parents must be registered parishioners. Sessions are held periodically at parishes throughout the Deanery. It is always preferred that baptisms be celebrated during a regular Sunday Liturgy. Call the Parish office for more information.

Eucharist – Children preparing for Eucharist (Gr. 3) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.

Confirmation – High School youth who are entering the 11th grade and who are active in the Faith Formation process or attend a Catholic High School since 9th grade are eligible to enter the Confirmation preparation sessions.

R.C.I.A. - Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults are initiated into the Church through this process. Any individual who may be interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church is invited. Please call the Church office.

Matrimony – There is a required preparation process which normally includes 3 sessions with the pastor and an Engagement Encounter or Nova experience. Please notify the pastor at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick-Celebrated for all who are seriously ill annually at a parish Liturgy. The Sacrament is also available upon

Reconciliation – The sacrament is celebrated weekly on Saturday from 4:45 – 5:15 p.m., or anytime by request.
