#### A Valiant Woman of Faith from Pennsylvania Katherine Drexel

The opening paragraph in the book, <u>Saint of the Day</u>, the author/editor Leonard Foley, O.F.M., begins to describe the saint, Katherine Drexel, in the following way:


"If your father is an international banker and you ride in a private railroad car, you are not likely to be drawn to a life of voluntary poverty. But, if your mother opens your home to the poor three days each week, and your father spends half an hour each evening in prayer, it is not impossible that you will devote your life to the poor and give away 12 million dollars. Katherine Drexel did that."

We are honored to know that she was born in Philadelphia, which is not far from here. She had everything a wealthy girl would want; did much traveling, popularity, and the best education money could buy. In the midst of all of this, Katherine discovered that she had a heartfelt compassion for those who suffer. She learned this about herself while taking care of her terminally ill step mother.

Eventually, Katherine's compassion reached out to the Native Americans and the African Americans in the states of Wyoming and the Dakotas. She gave much aid to Indian Missions. Her accomplishments were many: she inspired women to follow her in the religious life as nuns whose order was called, The Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament, for Indians and African Americans; opened a boarding school in Santa Fe; established schools in 13 states and 50 mission centers in several states. She founded Xavier University in New Orleans for African Americans and also Drexel University in Philadelphia is named after her. The last several years of her life was spent in quiet prayer and meditation, due to her limited health situation.

Katherine is a great example of one as Jesus says in our Gospel Reading today as he describes a good person: "A good person out of the store of goodness in his heart produces good." (Luke 6: 45a)
