Scripture Reflection and Questions

Brothers and sisters, I would like us to reflect briefly on this Second Reading for this weekend and then to answer the questions after reading this reflection.

> "That I, Paul, might not become too elated, because of the abundance of the revelations, a thorn in the flesh was given to me, an angel of Satan, to beat me, to keep me from being too elated. Three times I begged the Lord about this, that it might leave me, but He said to me, "My Grace is sufficient for you, for power is made perfect in weakness." I will rather boast most gladly of my weaknesses, in order that the power of Christ may dwell with me. Therefore, I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and constraints, for the sake of Christ; for when I am weak, then I am strong." (2 Corinthians 12: 7-10)

St. Paul had some struggles that he had to work through with the Corinthian community. In addition to this, St. Paul had to work through some personal issues and weaknesses that he named as being, "a thorn in the flesh." (2 Cor 12: 7) What St. Paul did to cope with and even find healing was to pray about each problem and give them completely to Jesus our Savior. When St. Paul did this, he felt and he knew that our Lord's Grace took over his life and controlled the situation. In this he sensed that Christ was telling him, "My Grace is sufficient…" (2 Cor 9)

Each one of us has an issue or some problem in our life, whether spiritually or physically. When we go to God in prayer, it is helpful to pray for the grace and truth in order to understand what is going on in our life. Our Lord will be faithful and show us that His Grace is enough. Here are two questions for us to answer:

- 1. What is one weakness that you are giving to God and asking for His Help?
- 2. Have you felt that God's Grace is sufficient for you in working through an issue?

God is always faithful in giving us the grace we ask for because He loves us.

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism – A baptism preparation session is required of all parents wishing to have their child(ren) baptized. Parents must be registered parishioners. Sessions are held periodically at parishes throughout the Deanery. It is always preferred that baptisms be celebrated during a regular Sunday Liturgy. Call the Parish office for more information.

Eucharist – Children preparing for Eucharist (Gr. 3) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.

Confirmation – High School youth who are entering the 11th grade and who are active in the Faith Formation process or attend a Catholic High School since 9th grade are eligible to enter the Confirmation preparation sessions.

R.C.I.A. – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults are initiated into the Church through this process. Any individual who may be interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church is invited. Please call the Church office.

Matrimony – There is a required preparation process which normally includes 3 sessions with the pastor and an Engagement Encounter or Nova experience. Please notify the pastor at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.
